he Ohio Valley Chapter's annual Educational, Networking and Golf event will take place at the Kennsington Golf Club in Canfield, Ohio on September 19, 2019. As a prelude to this year's event, we will have 3 guest speakers discussing topics related to health and safety, quality control and understanding lubricants.

Teeing off the event at 8:00 am will be Dan Sowry from EPA-Ohio. Dan's presentation will highlight the major areas of compliance, provide you with resources to gain a complete understanding of the requirements, and explain the proper management of common waste streams.

A Fairway shot by Gene Klein of Parkway Kew at 9:00 am will discuss how to adjust taper and radius to maximize production on wire drawing blocks and eliminate marking of the wire. Also how to choose the correct type of hard-surfacing for your type of wire.

Addressing the putt at 10:00 am will be Richard Janosky of MRG Laboratories with a focus on optimizing performance and life of the wire die and other plant lubricants with periodic sampling and analysis.

Moving from the conference room to the golf course will commence following the educational seminars. Attendees will have 1 hour to waste all of their best shots at the practice range, grab a snack bar lunch, courtesy of Rainbow Plastics, and it's out to the course. A steak dinner will follow with all of the skill prizes.
